Abbreviations in parentheses suggest when the hymn may be used:

Pro = Processional Hymn, Off = Offertory Hymn, Com = Communion Hymn, Rec = Recessional Hymn.

Titles preceded by an asterisk (\*) indicate the hymn is not in *The Hymnal 1982* or its supplement, *Wonder, Love and Praise*. Because the congregation attending a funeral service is composed of people from various denominations, it is acceptable to include some hymns other than those from the Anglican tradition.
